Conductors need tools just like mechanics and carpenters. In addition to the knowledge and skillsets to program music, rehearse a choir, and execute a performance, we also must ensure our ensembles run smoothly and properly. Tech can help.

**We recommend conductors adopt apps/software solutions for the following categories:**

## COLLABORATION IN THE CLOUD

### G-Suite (Google Drive)

*Practical uses:*

- shared cloud space to provide organizational reference documents to other ensemble leaders
- leadership collaboration on marketing and administrative documents
- collection of ensemble information through Google Forms
- shared databases of music, audience contacts, promotional materials, etc.



*Similar alternatives:* OneDrive, Dropbox, Box.net

### Airtable

*Practical uses:*

- Grid view (one of the many formats) allows you to see your information as a spreadsheet which can be organized based on category, priority, department, deadline, and more
- You can integrate Airtable with all of the other apps you use, such as G-Suite, Facebook, MailChimp, Slack, LinkedIn, Dropbox, and many more
- Create “smart relationships” by linking relatable items across different tables

## TASK MANAGERS

### Todoist

*Practical uses:* managing any and all personal & professional projects

*Similar alternatives:* Google Tasks, Asana, Any.Do, Things



## EMAIL CORRESPONDENCE

Look for:

- defer until later
- send later
- third-party integration

### TextExpander

*Practical uses:*

- answer common emailed questions with a TextExpander form letter



- quickly insert names, email and mailing addresses, and phone numbers into web forms
- type long, complicated composer names in a few keystrokes
- insert the full citation of a book that you reference all the time
- paste the text of checklists you use all the time

## GROUP POLLING & SCHEDULING

### Doodle

*Practical uses:*

- No time wasted with back-and-forth conversations about scheduling
- The app easily informs you when people are responding to the polls
- Simple and efficient design

*Similar alternatives:* PollUnit, Xoyondo



## APPOINTMENTS

### WhenWorks

*Practical uses:*

- coffee meetings with singers and board members
- college student office hour appointments
- avoid guessing when scheduling conference calls in other time zones

*Similar alternatives:* Calendly, YouCanBookMe, Google Appointments



## GROUP COMMUNICATIONS

### Remind

*Practical uses:*

- sending important announcements or reminders
- communicating last-minute venue changes or cancelations
- easily dispersing a link the entire group needs

*Similar alternatives:* Charms

### GroupMe

*Practical uses:*

- provides a forum for singers to both discuss relevant ensemble topics AND non-choir related fellowship
- an easy way to share reminders, announcements, and media

*Similar alternatives:* Slack, Band




## MARKETING-GRAPHIC DESIGN

### Canva

#### *Practical uses:*

- Hundreds of free design options and templates
- Dimensions are available for every media platform
- Easily convertible into PNG, PDF, JPEG

*Similar alternatives:* PowerPoint



## MARKETING-EMAIL

### Mailchimp

#### *Practical uses:*

- advertise upcoming performances to your mailing list
- announce audition opportunities for your ensemble
- share your organization's latest news with your supporters
- send rehearsal notes & media to large number ensembles

ConstantContact, Emma, Benchmark



## MARKETING-SOCIAL MEDIA

### Facebook Pages

#### *Practical uses:*

- Facebook GROUPS can be invitation-only and give the users the opportunity to post on the board and communicate easily about events, questions, etc.
- Facebook PAGES are profiles that users can follow. Create a FB Page if you'd like your group to subscribe to updates and have the ability to comment.

*Similar alternatives:* Instagram (not as collaborative)

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
